Monte Azul comprises 4 river-front suites and a private hilltop villa. The concept centers on the marriage of fine art, Nature's unspoiled fauna and foliage and common-sense environmentally friendly practices.

- Monte Azul sets aside 90% of the 125 acre property as a conservation area.
- Plants a tree for every guest who stays at the hotel.
- 100% of the staff is from the immediate community
- Non-smoking
- Organic produce served in the restaurant Café Blue is grown on site. Products not grown on site are purchased locally. The coffee is 100% organic and grown on site.
- Most of the furniture is designed and produced on site using salvaged, recycled and certified woods.
- The hiking footpaths have been carefully designed by local experts in order to minimize the human impact on the land and the flora and fauna along the way.
- The local organic farmers' market is a direct result of Monte Azul's participation in the community.
